WATERING CANE

This holiday season, the HandyCane simplifies the once-dreaded task of watering the Christmas tree. The 42-inch lightweight candy-cane shaped device separates into two pieces — the “hook,” which is the top curved part of the HandyCane, and the long, hollow tube, which is the base of the HandyCane. To water a Christmas tree, fill the hook with water, place the tube on the top edge of the tree stand, and pour the water from the hook down the tube into the tree stand. No more crawling on hands and knees underneath the tree with a pitcher or watering can, spilling water on the floor and getting poked in the eye by pine needles.
