According to the folks behind HandyCane, there will be "no more crawling on hands and knees underneath the tree with a pitcher or watering can, spilling water all over the floor and getting poked in the eye by pine needles." Imagine! The lightweight product, a 42-inch device that looks like a candy cane, holds water in the top arch that can be poured down the long, hollow tube directly into the tree stand.
